▶ PSA Peugeot Citroën reorganises its Executive Committee with a Board member to be based in Asia

To enable the Group to attain its strategic objectives, Philippe Varin has decided to make organisational changes in several areas, with the goal of strengthening management's global scope and operating efficiency.

Effective 1 September 2010, the four members of the Managing Board, which is chaired by Philippe Varin, will have the following responsibilities:

- Grégoire Olivier will be in charge of operations in Asia (China, Japan, India and the ASEAN countries). He will be based in Shanghai.
- Styling, Projects and Engineering operations will join the Research and Development Department, which will also include the Group's Research and Innovation operations. The Department will be headed by Guillaume Faury.
- The Brands Department, headed by Jean-Marc Gales, now includes Marketing and Product operations.
- The responsibilities of Frédéric Saint-Geours, head of Finance and Strategic Development, are unchanged.

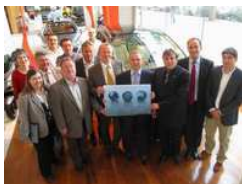
